- 5 minutes questions

The focus is on communicating how and why your proposal will solve the most important or urgent problems you have discovered in the case material. You must convince a panel of judges of your solution's ethicalness, suitability and chances of success.

2. CPA Alberta Business Challenge Competition

- No access to the Internet
- Presentation max 12 minutes
- Each team member must be a part of the presentation and teams will be awarded additional marks if all team members participate in answering questions.
- Business attire is required for presentations.
- PowerPoint Presentation Rules
 - 1. There is no limit to the number of slides that may be used.
 - 2. The use of pictures, video clips or sound clips are not permitted.
 - 3. Competitors are permitted to use the Drawing toolbar and Smart Art i.e. circles, lines, boxes, text boxes, arrows, etc.
